Item #2 Meeting to accommodate Special Needs Members

Comments: Discussion on this subject spanned almost the entire meeting.

-- Statements to object to the meeting:

Al Anon does not divide into people with ordinary and special needs
This creates chaos, does not Keep It Simple, member does not see the need
The creation of a special focus isolates people and does not give them a complete experience of
the program

There are not enough chairs for the meetings we have as it is

"There are laws [ie in the United States] against segregation of any kind."

Does old age count as a disability or a special need? Grief over the death of a loved one?

(sincere inquiries as to what counts as a special need...)

-- Statements to affirm the meeting:

Special needs meetings do exist and are represented in the Service Manual as Special Focus Meetings

Al Anon recognizes special focus meetings of various types for Spanish Speaking, Gay Bisexual Lesbian Transgender etc.

All are open to all Al Anons but they have provisions in their formats to address the special focus

From the 2014-2017 Service Manual p 36:

Some relatives and friends of alcoholics find it easier to address their common problems in dealing with the effects of someone else's drinking with those in similar life situations. These members have formed Al Anon groups for men, women, parents, adult children, and gays and lesbians (LGBT). The group may include these designations in its group name, with the understanding that, as with all Al Anon groups, membership remains open to anyone affected by someone else's drinking. Members of these groups are encouraged to attend other Al -Anon meetings as well.

In the 90s there was a special focus meeting in a specific geographic area named for people of color

apparently this meeting was registered with WSOat the time

One member helped Spanish Speakers to have their own meetings on their own line because she wanted to be sure they had a place to be heard "When anyone, anywhere reaches out for help..." Al Anon Declaration

This would just be another Special Focus meeting, like the Spanish Speaking Meetings

(possibility that special needs members need their own phone lines)

(member mentioned that there are other lines with smaller, slower meetings that do address this need)

Lone Member Service (old service manual p 68 to 69) is now covered by the Phone Bridge Special accommodations for those with special needs are no longer available through Lone Member Services

[Old] Service Manual also made reference to members who are:

"...home bound due to illness, disability, or other lifestyle restrictions..."

(these are the ones formerly served by the Lone Member Service, via land mail and phone contact)

This meeting would be inclusive of all Al Anons, but have accommodations for special needs in the format

We are not labeling people or encouraging labeling - people see this need and want to create these meetings

People vary in the nature of their disabilities,

Some can be seen (f2f), heard (bridge) some not

People don't hear from [me] much because [my] voice is so soft,

[my] hands have trouble muting/unmuting the phone

Fully-abled people may not be able to see/feel what this is like,

how easily special needs members may be drowned out by stronger voices and quicker fingers

All anyone needs is to be in an accident of some kind and

suddenly they will be special needs too...and know how this is...and learn what they do not know right now...

Having this discussion raised awareness of the need to recognize those with special needs

-- Proposals on this item

Perhaps an announcement can be added to a format at the beginning of any regular meeting to accommodate special needs members ie when newcomers to Al Anon and to the bridge speak

Allowances placed in one format may serve as a model for others to follow

It is important to remember that each group is autonomous, has its own business meeting to manage its format

There is a need for broad announcements

The option needs to be made available for those with and without computers

Those with special needs may not be on the Tech Service Business meeting

Timing of the meeting could be impacted by the specific scheduling needs of some special needs members

Two times proposed, 2PM Wednesday and 6PM Sunday

Suggestion to put the format up for the 6PM Sunday meeting since a chair stepped up and see how it goes

Two members offered contact info for follow up on this issue and on the Marathon on March 17 2015

Recap of the purpose of the meeting: to provide a place to discuss scheduling the space and to provide a forum to better understand the use of technology for phone bridge meetings.
