T Mobile and Metro PCS are blocking people from bridge now. Below is the Owners of conference calls response to this. Please tell other to follow the suggestions of calling 1-888- CALL-FCC. to complain.

We are very sorry for the issue. Currently T-Mobile and Metro PCS are threatening to charge you 1 cent per minute for calling into your conference call service or are flatly blocking your call. Presumably you signed up for an unlimited plan and are now finding that plan is not "unlimited". We are going through our legal channels to address it from the conference call provider. It would help ending this illegal practice if you would file a complaint with your carrier and with the FCC (https://consumercomplaints.fcc.gov/hc/en-us) or by calling 1-888-CALL-FCC (1-888-225-5322).

Please include in your complaint these activities that are illegal if they apply to you:

- Interrupting your call completion and inserting their own unsolicited interactive voice response message
- Not completing your call
- Not providing the agreed upon "unlimited" package

Please take the time to file the complaint and hopefully these carriers will stop their illegal activity. No Cost Conference, Inc does not benefit from this "extra" charge in any way. It is completely arbitrary and only serves to increase the profits at these already profitable companies. We are working with our lawyers through the FCC and our partners to stop this.

If you were considering changing phone providers this might be an excellent time.
